**The Upcoming Joint Meeting with Engineering and LS&A**

Toby Teorey noted that the Joint Engineering/LS&A Curriculum Committee meeting will be in two weeks (February 17). He stated that there already were two topics from Engineering and two topics from LS&A. The two Engineering topics are: The Ad Hoc Physics Committee (Susan Montgomery, Mahta Moghaddam, Richard Robertson and Fred Ward) with the information they have at that time and Brian Gilchrist will give a short presentation on the Multidisciplinary Design Minor. The two LS&A topics are: They have a new Math 215 syllabus they are trying to pass and they want to discuss it with this Committee. Also, there will be some discussion regarding Economics 101 and 102.

**Course Approval Forms**

There were no course approvals submitted for this meeting.

**EE Program Change**

Information regarding this Program change was included in the meeting packet and Mahta Moghaddam handed out a sample schedule at the meeting

The Proposal Summary is: **1.** Increase the number of credit hours required under Upper Level Electives (ULE) from 7 to 11 **2.** Accordingly, reduce the number of credit hours required under Flexible Technical Electives (FTE) from 14 to 10 **3** Require that at least 7 credit hours of ULE be at the 400 level or above.

There was some discussion regarding this. Toby Teorey asked for a motion to approve this change. This was moved and seconded. Approved.

## **Joint Institute Combined Ugrad/Grad Program**

Information regarding this proposed Program was included in the meeting packet. Jun Ni presented this proposed Program. The proposal is: a combined undergraduate/graduate program with the UM-SJTU joint Institute (JI) that will allow students receiving an undergraduate degree from the UM-SJTU Joint Institute to earn a M.S.E. OR MEng degree at the UM Ann Arbor while double counting no more than 6 credit hours between the two programs. There was some discussion regarding this proposal and some corrections were proposed.

Toby Teorey proposed that he will send an e-mail revision and ask the Committee for comments.

Jun Ni will make the required changes and send the revised Proposal to this Committee.

Toby asked for a vote approving the concept of the combined program, subject to the final approval of the modifications requested. This was moved and seconded. Approved.
