### **Prescribed Program—James Holloway**

### **Proposal for CoE Honors—Stacie Edington and James Holloway**

Information regarding this Proposal was included in the meeting packet and James Holloway handed out additional (and revised) information regarding this at the meeting.

James stated that there was discussion regarding a College of Engineering Honors Program for quite a few years. James and Stacie Edington presented this proposed Program.

Stacie noted that although the College has an EGL (Engineering Global Leadership) Program, that program only meets the needs of some select students and is not as widespread as this progressed Program.

“The College of Engineering Honors Program will identify highly talented students who demonstrate extraordinary academic ability, intellectual curiosity and clear potential to make a difference as a leader in their field. Students will pursue challenging coursework and enrich their academics through significant engagement beyond the classroom. Two programs will be developed to cultivate an academically enriching community a CoE Honors Program (for upper-classmen) and an engineering First-year Honors Program. These programs will inspire and enable highly-motivated students to reach beyond the traditional curricular outcomes.

There were some questions and discussion regarding this and the Committee was asked for feedback so a revised Proposal can be made and brought to the next (March 20, 2012) CoE CC meeting.
